Role title: Volunteer Workshop Assistant

Role outline: Reeltime Music exists to inspire young people through creative activities. We

are looking for enthusiastic volunteers to help assist in the delivery of creative music and media workshops in our studio and in various locations across

North Lanarkshire

What will I be doing?

You will be helping our tutors work with various groups of young people on creative projects. This will include setting up a variety of equipment, tutoring young people on instruments, storyboarding and filming music videos and working closely with the young people to help build their interpersonal skills.

What skills & experience will I need?

You need to have experience of playing and teaching musical instruments (knowledge of more than one instrument is preferred). To evidence this, we are looking for an up to date example of your work (online or otherwise).

You also need to have good social skills, as well as an ability to follow instructions closely.

When will I do this?

We would look for a commitment of one workshop (approx. three hours) per week.

Workshops will take place at a variety of times (both day & night) between Monday to Friday. Most sessions will be between three and four hours in length.

Who will I work with?

The project is led by our volunteer co-ordinator John Gray. You will also work with our team of tutors on a day to day basis.

Will I need any specialist equipment?

No equipment is required. All workshops will be delivered using equipment in the Reeltime studio or at locations arranged by Reeltime. Any travel to workshops will be made using the Reeltime van or co-ordinated by Reeltime staff.

Will I get support & training?

You will get regular feedback on your work from Reeltime staff. We will also offer our tutor training programme for volunteers. Our volunteer co-ordinator will meet with you regularly to offer support.
